

## Guidelines:

This tour is designed to introduce kids to a structured tournament setting. Yes, there are rules to follow, and there will be winners, but our main objective is for the kids to have fun and keep playing the game they enjoy. If there are rule infractions we want the kids to learn from their mistakes and handle it amongst themselves, not the parents. If issues continue to arise, please reach out to Matt Sauter/Nick Foster at Crestview Golf Club or Doug Bishop at MD's Golf Academy and we will handle accordingly.

- All players are required to pay a \$5.00 registration fee prior to their first event.
- All players are required to pay the host facility \$5.00 prior to their tee time.
- All players must be registered by 5p.m. on Tuesday prior to the event they wish to play in. To register, you must email your name and the event you're playing in to Nick at Crestview, [nickfoster@live.com](mailto:nickfoster@live.com). Anyone trying to register after the deadline will not be accepted.
- All players should report to the course at least 20 minutes prior to their tee time. Tee Times will be made available by 9a.m. on Thursday prior to the event. Tee Times will be posted on the tours website, Facebook, and emailed. It is the responsibility of the player to know their tee time.
- USGA Rules as well as Local Rules will be played at each facility.
- The tour will be playing Double Par Max on each hole. This applies in all age groups (Par 3 = 6 / Par 4 = 8 / Par 5 = 10).
- All spectator carts are a first come, first serve basis at each facility. Cost of spectator carts will be the same at each facility. (\$20.00 for 18 Holes - \$10.00 for 9 Holes - \$5.00 for 3 Holes)
- Winners will be awarded their plaques at the conclusion of the event or they can pick it up at Crestview the Tuesday after the event.
- Results from each event will be emailed and posted the following Monday.
